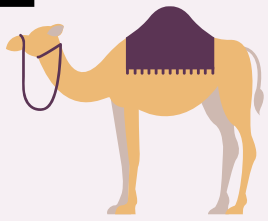
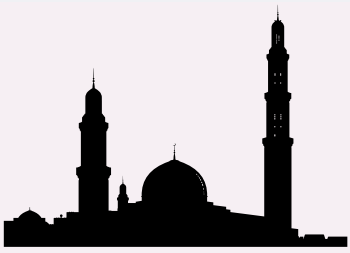

HISTORY OF SLAUGHTERING

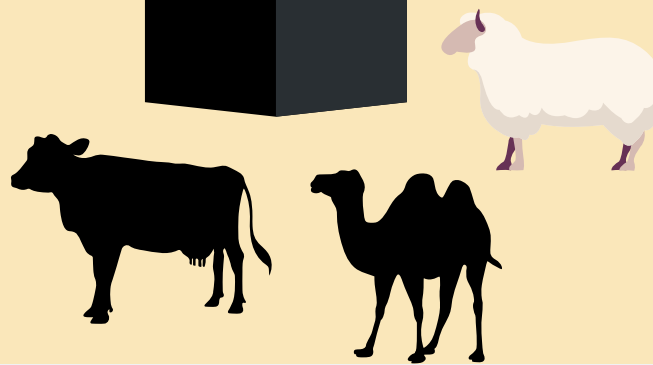
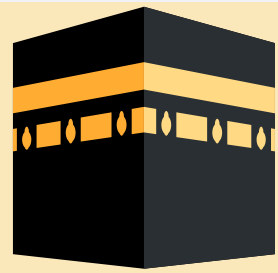
Can be traced back in Islam as early as the time of Prophet Ibrahim when he was commanded by Allah to slaughter his own son.

THE HADY

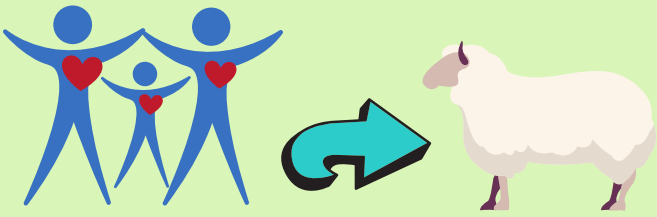
It is a legally edible animal brought to the Sacred Mosque, slaughtered there, and sacrificed for the sake of Allah by those who perform umrah in the month of Hajj (Hajj at-Tamattu and Al Qiran) if he can afford it.

THE UDHIYAH



1 Family = 1 Sacrifice

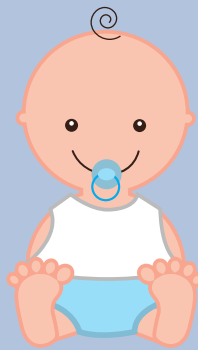
Narrated from al-Baraa' ibn 'Aazib (may Allaah be pleased with him) that Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "Whoever offers a sacrifice after the prayer has completed his rituals (of Eid) and has followed the way of the Muslims."

THE AQEEQAH

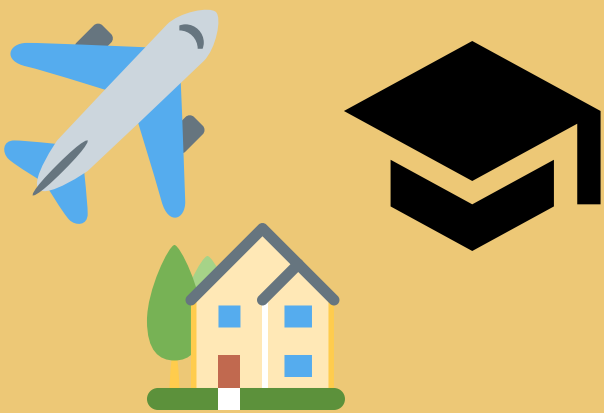
Narrated from Salmaan ibn 'Aamir al-Dabbi that said: I heard the Messenger of Allaah (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) say: 'Aqeeqah is to be offered for a (newly born) boy, so slaughter (an animal) for him, and remove all dirt from him.'

Narrated from Samurah ibn Jundub that the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "Every child is in pledge for his 'aqeeqah, which should be sacrificed for him on the seventh day and his head should be shaved and he should be given a name."

Narrated by al-Tirmidhi, 1522, he said it is hasan saheeh; Ibn Maajah, 3165; Saheeh Ibn Maajah, 2563).



THE SLAUGHTERING TO SHOW GRATITUDE TOWARDS ALLAH

When Prophet Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) came back from a journey he would sacrifice a camel and invite the people to eat.
