# Discover CU-Quran - Ramadhan 1443

### SURAH AL-A'RAAF: 31

# يَابَنِىٓ ءَادَمَ خُذُواْ زِينَتَكُمْ عِندَ كُلِّ مَسْجِدٍ وَكُلُواْ وَٱشْرَبُواْ وَلَا تُسْرِفُوٓا ۗ إِنَّهُۥ لَا يُحِبُّ ٱلْمُسْرِفِينَ

O Children of Adam! Take your adornment to every Masjid, and eat and drink, but waste not by extravagance, certainly He (Allah) likes not the wasteful.

## This beautiful aayah can be described into 3 parts:

- 1. Allah's SWT commandment to TAKE ADORNMENT to the House of Allah (Masjid)
- 2. Eat and drink and DON'T WASTE (over limit)
- 3. Allah DISLIKE those who trespass the limits

#### 1st PART: To take Adornment to Masjid -ADAB to Meet ALLAH.

- This Ayah refutes the idolaters' practice of performing Tawaf in Kaabah. During that time, all Mushrikin Makkah performed Tawaaf while naked (men and women) as follow of their ancestors' tradition.
- Then, Allah SWT ordered to not follow them but to dress properly and beautifully when performing Ibadah.
- Meaning: When you come to pray, dress beautifully with nice clothes, good scents body and mouth.

#### 2nd PART: Eat and Drink, but waste not - Live your Life but Don't Over Limit.

- We live our life, we eat, we drink (and we wear) what we want but don't be excessive.
- Allah forbids us to have an extravagance life (To have things that is not necessary, this is extravagance)
- · Hadith: "Eat what you wish and wear what you wish, as long as you avoid two things: extravagance and arrogance. (Bukhari)

#### 3rd Part: Allah DISLIKE the wasteful people

- This is a warning from Allah to us Bani Adam. To have moderate life according to our needs (Every person has different needs & capacity)
- Allah SWT does not like those who trespass the limits on an allowed matter: THOSE who go to the extreme over what He has allowed (eg: Eat Vegan only)
- and also Allah SWT does not like those who allow what He has prohibited (eg: Eat excessively)

#### **Lessons from this Aayah:**

- Dress properly and beautifully to meet Allah SWT (every point of Salah)
- Follow the Sunnah of our Prophet SAW. How he lives his life.
- Everything that we have will be asked by Allah SWT in the Day of Judgment.
- We are UMMATAN WASATA. we live our life moderately
- We eat but we don't over eat We spend but we don't overspend - We sleep but we don't over-sleep

May Allah SWT keep us all away from Excessiveness and Arrogance, Ameeen!
